YOU WILL NOT BE SENT A TUITION BILL. CHECK YOUR BILL ONLINE

***Avoid Long Lines! Once you have completed your registration, please go to the Office of the Bursar, Room C-110, to settle your registration bill. If your balance due is \$200 or more, you must settle your registration bill by the close of business according to the payment due date schedule on this flyer.**

Failure to do so will result in cancellation of your registration. For your convenience, we offer the following payment options:

Enroll for only **\$16.75** and a **percentage** of your current semester tuition balance (www.tuitionpay.com/cuny).
- **Credit Cards** (MasterCard, American Express and Discover cards by utilizing your **CUNY first account**) **VISA CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED!!!!**
- **Only Cash, Checks & Money Orders** are accepted at the Bursar's Window (C-110).
- **All Checks & Money Orders** made payable to **LaGuardia Community College**. Be sure to write your EMPLID number.

HOW TO PAY

1. Web Payment

Go to <https://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu> to pay your bill online using your **CUNYfirst account**

- **E-Check** has no processing fee.
- **Credit card** (MasterCard, Amex or Discover only).
- There is a **2.65 %** processing fee.

****The FAFSA deadline for Spring 2013 is Dec. 15, 2012. **** All documentation has to be submitted by **Jan. 17, 2013**. If you missed these deadlines, you will be expected to enroll in a **TuitionPay** payment plan. Any financial aid appearing on your bill is **ESTIMATED** and subject to change.

If your financial aid does not cover your entire tuition and fees, you must pay the remaining balance by the close of business on your scheduled payment deadline.

6. Financial Aid

Any financial aid appearing on your bill is **ESTIMATED** and subject to change. If your financial aid does not cover your entire tuition and fees, you must settle the remaining balance by the close of business on the payment deadline.

7. Third Party Voucher

You must submit a voucher or an official letter from your employer or union to the Office of the Bursar (C-110) by the close of business on the payment deadline.

*****IMPORTANT*****

If you do not make full payment on your tuition and fees and other college bills and your account is sent to a collection agency, you will be responsible for all collection costs, including agency fees, attorney fees and court costs, in addition to whatever amounts you owe the college.

In addition, non-payment or a default judgment against your account may be reported to a credit bureau and reflected in your credit report.

Important Facts

- Financial Aid Checks are disbursed in October/November for the Fall semester and April/May for the Spring semester. Financial Aid Checks are directly mailed to students. If you do not receive your check in the mail, you may contact the Office of the Bursar. **Note:** Direct Deposit or the CUNY Scholar Support Prepaid Card is also available at your request.
- A Bursar service indicator will be placed on your student account if you have an outstanding balance resulting from any unpaid financial aid, balance due to college, book voucher, bad check, emergency loans and/or TuitionPay payment plan delinquency.
- Please refer to the Drop/Withdrawal policy on our Bursar web site: <http://www.laGuardia.edu/bursar> and/or college catalog when dropping or withdrawing from classes. **Note:** There is a significant difference when dropping and/or withdrawing from a course as it may affect your registration bill.
- You can enroll in our TuitionPay payment plan for only \$16.75 and a percentage of your current semester tuition balance, if your financial aid is not appearing on your bill. Once it is determined that you are entitled to receive financial aid, your payment plan may be canceled at our discretion. If this results in a refund, it may be included in your financial aid check or a refund check may be generated and mailed to you.
